Lionshead Pilsner (Wilkes-Barre, PA)

Classic Standard American Lager. Crisp, clean and slightly dry with some residual sweetness, it is very refreshing and thirst quenching. We use the finest American two-row and six-row barley and corn. Domestic hops add just a touch of bitterness. **\$3**

Blue Grass Brewing Co. Nut Brown Ale

(Louisville, KY)

Nut Brown Ale has a diverse grain bill, which lends this traditional English ale a variety of flavors that coalesce into a remarkably smooth and pleasant drink. Additions of various pale, caramel and dark malts create a smooth, sweet malt profile with hints of roasted nuttiness. Multiple additions of English hops round out the flavors and give this classic beer a true flavor of the Old World. **\$5**

Blue Mountain Classic Lager (Afton, VA)

This authentic Continental-style beer is brewed with 2-row malts and noble hops, then cold fermented and lagered for six glorious weeks. Experience the full, balanced malt flavor. **\$5**

Blue Mountain Foreign Stout (Afton, VA)

Clear very dark brown color with a medium sized creamy tan head. Aroma of roasted malts, chocolate, tobacco, herbal hops. The taste is chewy, roasted malts, chocolate, caramel, stone fruits, herbal hops. Medium-full bodied, low bitterness, good balance. **\$5**

Blue Mountain Lights Out Holiday Ale

(Afton, VA)

This Holiday Old Ale features a deep malt flavor and earthy hop spiciness given by whole-flower Willamette hops. A range of English crystal malts come forward and, combined with rolled oats, finish with a medium-bodied texture. **\$5**

Blue Mountain Cheer Beer (Afton, VA)

Amber Ale with Crystal malts, London ale yeast and HUGE American hop flavor and aroma. **\$5**

Abita Brewing Co. Amber (Abita Springs, LA)

Amber is a Munich style lager brewed with crystal malt and Perle hops. It has a smooth, malty, slightly caramel flavor and a rich amber color. **\$5**

Abita Brewing Co. Macchiato Espresso

Stout (Abita Springs, LA)

Macchiato is made with pale, caramel, chocolate, and roasted malts. Oats and lactose give the beer a more robust and sweeter taste. The roasted malts give the beer its dark color as well as its intense flavor and aroma. Willamette hops balance out the sweetness of the malts & PJ's Coffee espresso dolce beans are added to give the beer a strong coffee flavor and aroma that compliments the existing flavors of the malt. **\$5**

Terrapin Beer Co. Hopsecutioner (Athens, GA)

Brewed with six different hops to create an aggressive, yet exceptionally well-balanced, beer. Expect citrus and pine on the nose with a beautifully bitter finish; a strong malt backbone keeps the bitterness in check. **\$5**

Left Hand Brewing Co. Wake Up Dead

Imperial Stout (Longmont, CO)

This Russian Imperial Stout offers hints of raisins, black licorice, coffee and dark chocolate are followed by earthy, herbal hop notes. **\$5**

Parkway Brewing Co. Get Bent IPA (Salem, VA)

(Salem, VA)

A light bodied, west coast-styled IPA with a delightful bready character balanced by lots of citrusy hops. We expect it to be around 7.2 % ABV. **\$5**

Pabst Blue Ribbon American Style Premium Lager (Can)

Wines-Red

Dante Merlot Reserve – California • This tasty Merlot has a deep plum color and a hint of brick edges. The aromas are ripe blueberry and cocoa with a cassis lining. The palate features ripe huckleberry and raspberry flavors, but the beauty of this wine is that the fruit folds elegantly into the silk oak finish and parts with tannin, fruit and vanilla extract. This is a terrific red wine as an aperitif or everyday red sipper. Try it with eggplant parmesan, or hearty cheeses like aged Vermont white cheddar or Stilton. **\$6 glass/ \$22 full bottle**

Hess Select Cabernet Sauvignon – North Coast California • Notable richness, intensity and varietal character, showing jammy dark fruit aromas with cedary barrel notes and a touch of spice. A soft entry, with ripe plum and raspberry in the forefront, is supported by background flavors of tobacco and caramel, which add complexity to this imminently drinkable wine. **\$6 glass/ \$24 full bottle**

Fossi Chianti – Italy

• This Chianti opens up with a spicy bouquet with subtle notes of cinnamon. On the palate it transitions nicely into cherry, plum and raspberry flavors. An excellent everyday Chianti. **\$6 glass/ \$21 full bottle**

Specialty Drinks

Angry Orchard Hard Cider (Cincinnati, OH) • This crisp and refreshing cider offers sweet apple notes up front with a subtle dryness at the finish for a balanced cider taste. A hint of Fuji apples adds a layer of complexity and brings out a fresh apple aroma and slightly sweet, ripe apple flavor. **\$4**

Crispin Original Hard Apple Cider (Colfax, CA) • Crisp over ice. A classically styled, but untraditional hard apple cider. Fruit forward, with a fresh, crunchy apple nose and a deliciously refreshing, crisp mouth feel. **\$4**

Cornaro Pinot Grigio – Italy

• Well flavored and balanced, this Pinot Grigio opens surprisingly floral with meadow herbs and crisp watery stones. Zippy and refreshing, an ideal accompaniment for fish and light vegetable dishes.

Ventana Chardonnay – Monterey, California

• Light, yet fresh and focused, displaying tropical fruit notes of pineapple and mango. It is well balanced and tastes of Gala apple, pear and spicy floral tones. Light oak notes lead to hints of vanilla and honey highlights.

Heinz Eifel Riesling “Shine” – Germany

• This drier-style Riesling is bright, fruity and floral with crisp acidity and clean flavors of apple, pear and peach that compliment it's stony minerality and slightly earthy complexity. It serves well as an aperitif and matches a wide variety of foods, like lighter salad dishes, shellfish, cream sauces and also anything with a touch of spice. It could be a wonderful addition to any holiday meal. **\$6 glass/ \$21 full bottle**
